How Does SetBuilder Work?

SetBuilder makes it simple to organize and distribute large document sets.

Step 1: Set your headers

Headers are your document categories. You can also think of them as your table of contents.

Step 2: Add placeholders

Placeholders are where you plan which documents you need in a category and what order you need them in.

Step 3: Drop in your documents

SetBuilder accepts a variety of file types such as Word docs, PDFs, and Excel files.

Step 4: Compile your set

The magic of SetBuilder is its ability to compile all of your documents into a digital PDF for client delivery, saving you hard costs and shelf space.

Step 5: Clone your work
